Ovarian Cancer is the deadliest of all female cancers and there is **NO TEST!** For this reason funding education initiatives in our community is vital. For every woman that is diagnosed in early stage 1 or 2, they have a 90% chance to survive. Unfortunately most of our survivors are diagnosed late stage 3 or 4 which makes survival a very tough fight for them. Based on the 2009 American Cancer Society statistics Kentucky will have **431** NEW women diagnosed and **292** will die each year.
