## KNOW THE SYMPTOMS

- abdominal pressure, bloating or discomfort
- increased abdominal size or clothes fitting tighter around the waist
- increased or urgent need to urinate
- pelvic pain

## OTHER SYMPTOMS MAY INCLUDE

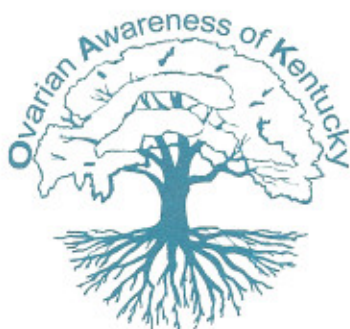
- constipation or diarrhea
- nausea, indigestion or gas
- unusual fatigue
- unexplained weight loss or gain
- shortness of breath
- low back pain
- loss of appetite
